



Appalachia Service Project (ASP) is a Christian ministry, open to all people, that inspires hope and service through volunteer home repair in Central Appalachia.

ASP utilizes volunteer labor throughout the year to address critical housing needs in five states: KY, NC, TN, VA, and WV. Home repair is free of cost to applicants.

Each year, ASP repairs or rebuilds over 600 homes across 5 states with the help of over 17,000 volunteers.

How do I apply?

Visit ASPhome.org/apply to submit an online application, or call (423) 854-8800 to have an application mailed. Applications remain on file for three years.

How can ASP help?

ASP is capable of taking on both small and large scale projects. The most common projects are roofs, ramps, porches, flooring, foundation repair, weatherization, and more. All repairs are dependent upon site safety, volunteer skill needed, time frame of projects, and resources available. ASP serves homeowners and renters with proper documentation and landlord approval.

Who does the work?

Home repairs are completed by youth (14+), college, and adult volunteers. They travel from over 35 states to make homes warmer, safer, and drier in Central Appalachia. Each group of volunteers usually stays for one week at a time.

Is this really free?

Yes! Repairs are completed at no cost to applicants, thanks to a generous donor base and volunteers. We do encourage community members and homeowners to spend time with volunteers, and swing a hammer if they are able!
