AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO AMENDMENT  
OF ORDINANCE NO. 2020-03 SO AS TO  
CHANGE THE BEGINNING AND EXPIRATION  
DATES OF ALCOHOL LICENSES

Be it ordained by the fiscal court of County of Boyd, Commonwealth of Kentucky:

Ordinance No. 2020-03 Article II, Section D, Expiration of License: Proration of Fees be  
and hereby is AMENDED as follows:

All county licenses, except temporary licenses, shall begin July 1 of any year  
and shall expire on June 30 of the following year as set forth in KRS 243.090 and  
804 KAR 4:390. Any licenses issued after July 20 of any year shall be assessed a fee  
which is based on the pro rata portion of the remainder of the license period; however, the cost of  
any license shall not be less than one-half (1/2) the amount of the full fee for an annual license of  
that type.

In consideration of the foregoing, the original Article II, Section D of Ordinance No.  
2020-03 be and hereby is stricken in its entirety with the foregoing amendment being substituted  
therefore and all other parts, articles and sections remaining in full force and effect and being  
incorporated herein by reference as if set out in full.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption, re-adoption and publication  
according to law.
